Whether your goal is to touch up trims between visits from a professional or to take over hoofcare duties for your herd entirely, this workshop will get you started off on the right foot – er, hoof!

Not quite ready to pick up a rasp yet? Audit the workshop to become a more educated consumer of hoofcare services – learn about healthy hoof anatomy and function, how to decide when your horse needs a trim, and how to recognize a balanced trim.
