What's this all about?

Join us for a two-day clinic on equine bodywork and massage – featuring Michelle Still, certified Equine Massage Therapist, of Equi-Kneads, Inc. - based in Blakely, GA.

Saturday - Day 1: Equine bodywork appointments with Michelle Still of Equi-Kneads, Inc. Equine Bodywork and Massage.

Limited to 7 horses - \$60 per horse - free to audit. \$10 additional per horse for day use of CPEC facilities.

Sunday - Day 2: Equine Bodywork Basics for Horse Owners - Michelle will present equine muscle and skeletal anatomy basics, and simple techniques that horse owners can use every day, to relieve some of the most common sites of muscular tension in horses. Classroom time in the morning, followed by hands-on coaching in the afternoon. Participants may bring their own horses, or borrow a horse that live on-site.

Limited to 10 participants - \$60 to participate, free to audit. \$10 additional per horse for day use of CPEC facilities.

What to wear and bring:

Wear work pants or jeans and sturdy shoes. No shorts or sandals, please – closed-toe shoes required for safety.

Bring a folding chair, notebook, pen, camera. Other classroom materials will be provided. Take all the photos and video you like!

Lunch and Drinks:

Lunch, snacks, and hot and cold beverages will be provided both days and are included in price of admission for participants – auditors, enjoy the drinks and snacks for free, but please plan to chip in \$5 for lunch. If you'd like to bring food to share, snacks that don't need refrigeration and that might double as dessert (fruit, muffins, cookies, brownies, bagels) are always appreciated!

Stalls and Campsites:

Stalls available, day or overnight use - \$10.00 per day. One campsite with electric and water hook-ups, \$20.00 per day. Two campsites with electricity, no water, \$10.00 per day. First come, first serve – contact Ed and Bonnie Dervage to reserve.

If you plan to participate in the Basic Bodywork for Horse Owners clinic, but won't be bringing a horse:

Please let us know in advance that you are planning to participate in the hands-on clinic on Sunday, but will not be bringing a horse – so that we can arrange to have a practice horse available.

If you plan to bring your horse (or mule or donkey) on Saturday, Sunday, or both:

In addition to the clinic cost payable to Leitha Lee, there is a \$10/day/horse charge for day use of the CPEC facilities – payable to Leitha Lee, or to Ed and Bonnie Dervage.

Stalls are available for day or overnight use - \$10/day, payable to Ed and Bonnie Dervage.

Please let us know in advance that you are planning to bring your horse, so we can prepare to comfortably accommodate him (or her).

Current negative Coggins for each visiting horse must be submitted with clinic registration forms or presented for inspection before unloading horse from trailer – no exceptions.

Plan to arrive 30 minutes early to check in and get your horse settled. Let us help direct you to trailer parking and turnaround.

Please bring your own water bucket and hay from home.

No stallions, ungelded colts, mares with foals at side, or fractious or unhandled horses.

This and that:

No visiting dogs, please. No smoking in the barn area or covered arena. Smoking is allowed on the opposite side of the gravel drive from the barn and covered arena.

Clinic participants and auditors must observe posted barn rules of Cash Point Equine Center.

The bathroom is located in the barn below the house, through the door halfway along the wall to your right as you enter the main doorway of the barn.

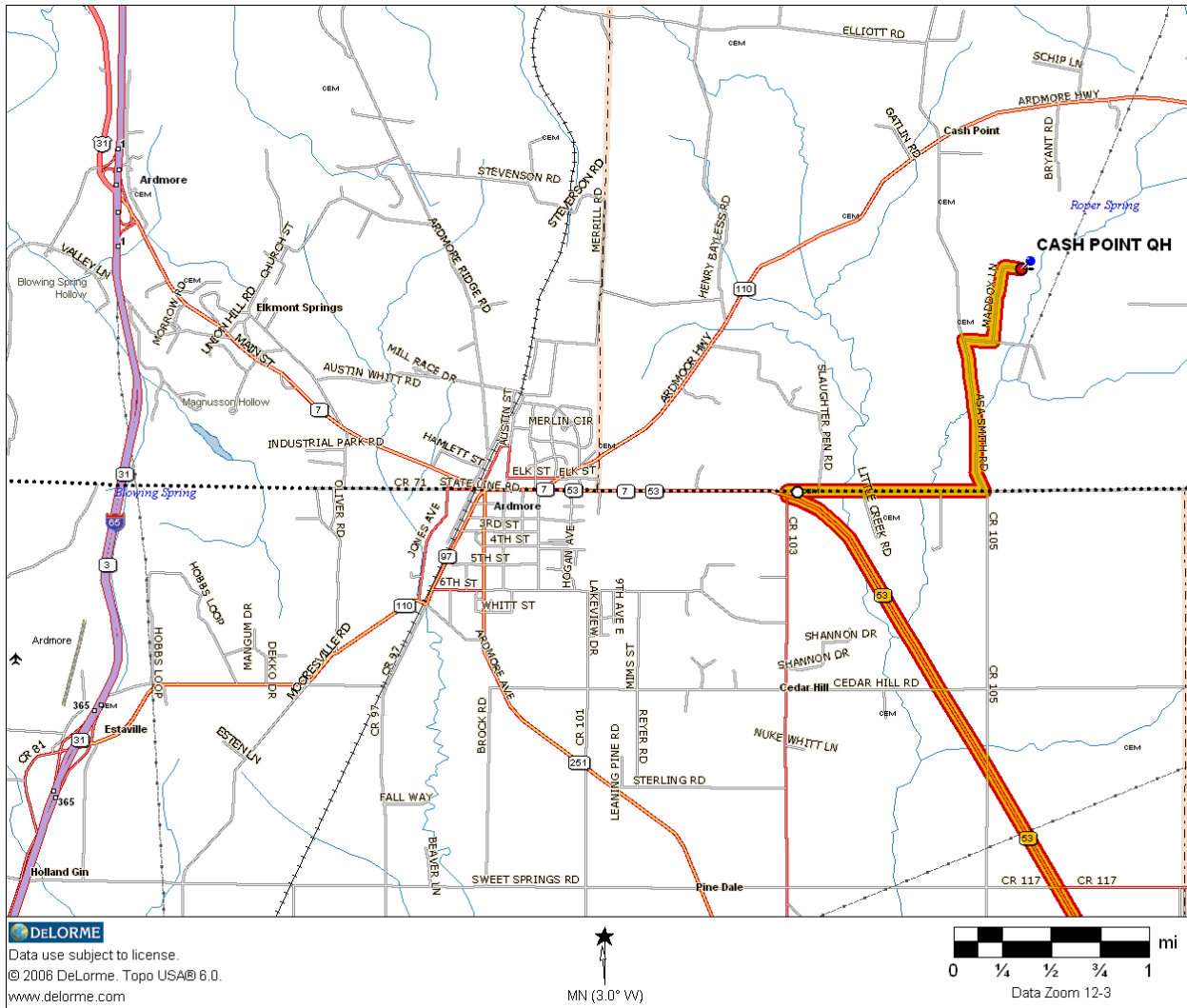
Inclement weather:

Turn sharp R at State Line Rd (just after
Pizza Inn on R)
Drive about 1.1 miles
Turn L on Asa Smith Rd (2nd L)
Turn R on Maddox Rd (first R)
Turn L on Maddox Ln (first L)
Please watch for loose dogs and drive
slowly on Maddox Ln.
Maddox Ln dead-ends at Cash Point Equine
Center.
